- The Scarecrow Trail - The fundraising highlight of our academic year, weeks and weeks of preparation go into the planning of this which continues to improve year on year. We had some fantastic feedback from the 2019 trail, and hopefully 2020 will be the best one yet! Again, we would not be able to run this event without the

support from the Lacock villagers, the National Trust and our huge group of volunteers who contributed in a variety of ways, so a huge thank you to everyone enabling us to raise such a huge chunk of our money from this event.

- Lacock at War - This was the first year that the FLS assisted the WI and Lacock at war selling hot drinks, and all went without a hitch thanks to the organisational prowess of Georgina Doel. Thank you to George and to all of the volunteers who went down to help out.

It is obvious from the above as-well that it is not only the FLS who volunteer their time and resources to enrich the children's' experiences, other members of the community are also invaluable to the success of the FLS.

At the start of last year Mr. Hearn approached us with what seemed like an endless list of requests, and I am delighted that as a PTA we were able to agree to the majority of these. This year we have spent some of the money raised on:
