Literacy

Lots of speech and language work involving the children asking and answering each other's questions.

The children will describe themselves and each other using adjectives and then move on to writing character descriptions.

The children will write labels and captions to accompany work completed in other curriculum areas.

Daily phonics sessions will take place alongside weekly spelling tests (year 1 and 2) and reading.

Overview

A lovely topic to kick off the new school year. The children will have great fun trying to recognise their friends from their baby photos and even the adults too.

PSHE

We will focus on what makes each child special and what relationships they have with those around them.

As it is the beginning of the school year, we will decide on our class rules and behaviour sanctions and rewards.

History

We will learn about changes in the children's own lives from being a baby, toddler, pre schooler and starting school. We will look at the changes in capability, physical development and even the type of toys they played with.

The children will need photos of themselves as babies and toddlers in school this term.



How have I changed Since I was a baby?


Music

This term's focus will be listening to and singing nursery and action rhymes.

We will also listen to a range of music styles before improvising and playing on classroom musical instruments.

Computing

Children will learn to recognise that different devices can be used to capture photographs and will gain experience capturing, editing, and improving photos. Finally, they will use this knowledge to recognise that images they see may not be real.

PE

This term we will be focusing on balance and controlling our bodies as we move around.

Geography

The children will learn about the geography of their school and how to find their way around it.

Art/DT

Our art focus this term will be drawing. The children will learn how to draw different body parts and create their own self portrait.

In DT the children will learn how to design, make and evaluate their own photograph frame design.



RE

We will focus on what we can do to show others that we care.

Science
