For the 2020 – 2021, Lacock will receive £17,960 and we had a carry forward of approximately £1,247.12 as a result of lack of activity due to covid and lockdown from March 2020.

At Lacock we want to promote a positive attitude to sport and encourage a lifelong participation. Our focus is to once again build on the success of last year's mentoring and CPD, to continue to encourage our children to develop a sustained interest in sport, physical exercise and healthy living, and to enhance general PE provision.
