For the 2021 – 2022, Lacock will receive £16,599 and we had a carry forward of approximately £1,247 from March 2021.

At Lacock we want to promote a positive attitude to sport and encourage a lifelong participation. Our focus is to once again build on the success of last year’s mentoring and CPD, to continue to encourage our children to develop a sustained interest in sport, physical exercise and healthy living, and to enhance general PE provision.
