## Beech Class Autumn 1 2023 Would you survive the Stone Age?



#### Science – Rocks – This planet rocks!

Comparing and grouping together different types of rocks depending on their appearance and simple physical properties. To be able to name 6 different rocks and understand how rocks are formed. Recognise erosion and find evidence of this. To be able to explain how fossils are formed and recognise the importance of Mary Anning.

#### Topic – Stone Age to Iron Age

We will develop a whole class time line through the Prehistoric ages from the Stone age to the Iron Age. Recognise how they were huntergathers and how they prepared their food – we will also have a little go! We will also learn about the development of homes and settlements and what life was like as a villager in those times.




