

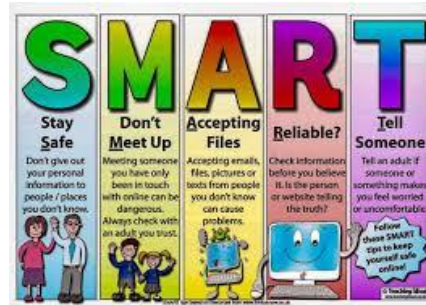

risk	An action which is taken in a hazardous situation
hazard	Something which could cause harm
dare	To challenge someone to do something as a test of courage
safe	Providing protection from harm, loss or danger
Influence	A thing or person that has the power to affect another.
consequences	The result that follows the action you have just done
Healthy	Being free from sickness, being well and fit

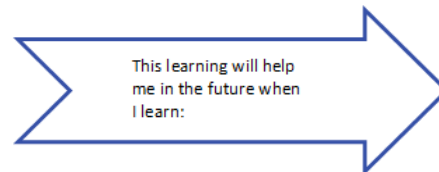


Key Skills
