Getting to know you

Art and DT – The rainforest

To create a diorama of the different layers of the rainforest. To research and create tribal homes found in the rainforests. To research and design Kayapo tribal art including headdresses and face masks.

Topic – The rainforest

Learning geographical vocabulary relating to the rainforest. Locating rainforests on a world map and recognising the relationship between them to the Equator. Understand the features of a rainforest in relation to the different layers. Explore the animals and plants that live in the rainforest. To explore an Amazonian Tribe.

Computing – Creating media

Animation – using programmes on the iPads to create our own animations.

PSHE – Valuing differences

Recognising that there are many different types of families. Understand what is meant by the terms ‘adoption, fostering and same-sex relationships. Be able to define the term ‘community’ and recognise that they belong to many communities.
