Important Vocabulary

audio	Sound that has been recorded
microphone	A device that changes sound waves into electronic signals, used to make sounds louder
speaker	An electronic device that produces sound
headphones	A sound receiver, held usually over both ears to hear the sound
Input device	A device that is used for putting data into a computer (keyboard, mouse, joystick)
Output device	A piece of hardware used to receive data from the computer (speakers for example)
podcast	A way of sharing information as digital audio files.
edit	To correct and prepare for the final piece
trim	To make the podcast neat by cutting away some parts that are not needed.
align	To place or arrange in a straight line
import	
playback	Replaying the sounds that have just been recorded

MP3	A computer file format for the storage of digital audio data
