

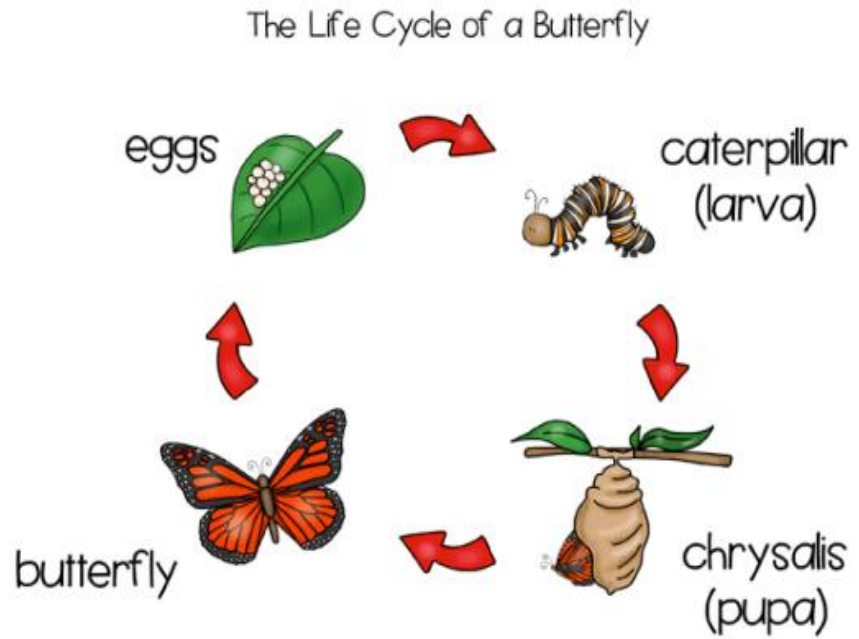


Lacock Primary School – EYFS Knowledge and Understanding of the World - Minibeasts

Habitat	<i>A place where something lives</i>
snail	<i>A slimy animal with a shell.</i>
woodlouse	<i>A small animal that can roll into a ball</i>
ladybird	<i>A small beetle with a red spotted shell.</i>
Bee	<i>A black and yellow flying insect.</i>
