Important Vocabulary

<i>seed</i>	<i>Part of a flowering plant that grows into a new plant</i>
<i>leaf</i>	<i>These are flat, thin and usually green.</i>
<i>stem</i>	<i>The upright main part of a plant.</i>
<i>root</i>	<i>The part of the plant that grows under the ground.</i>
<i>flower</i>	<i>The colourful part of a plant</i>
<i>bud</i>	<i>Growth on a plant that develops into a stem, leaf or shoot.</i>
<i>plant</i>	<i>A living thing</i>
<i>trunk</i>	<i>The large main stem of a tree.</i>
<i>branch</i>	<i>Part of a tree that grows out of the trunk.</i>

5. Trowel



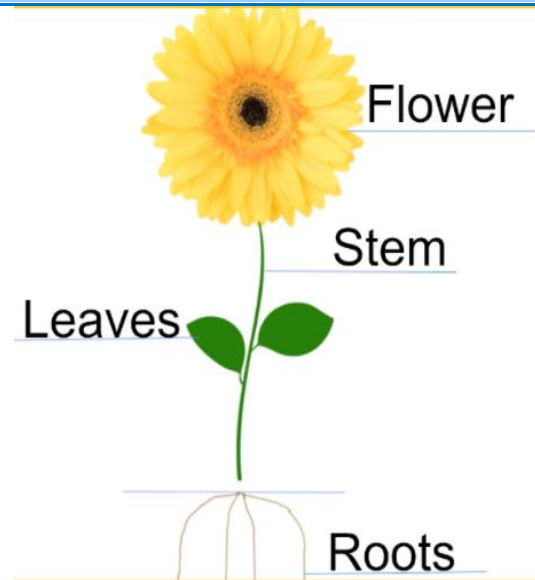
6. Plant label and pencil



You can plant and grow a seed at home and keep a record or look after a plant.

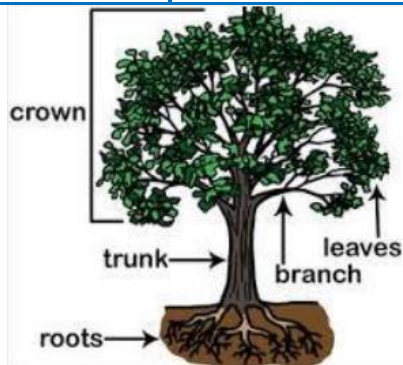
Key Skills
