

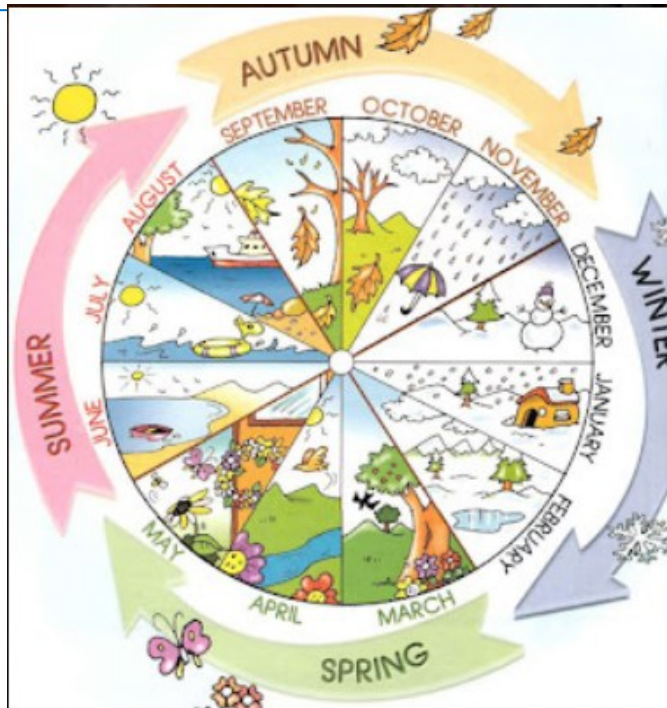

Important Vocabulary
