

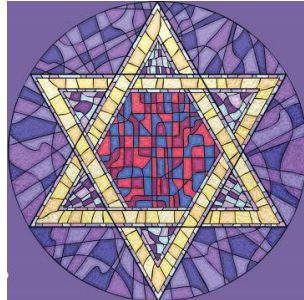

Judaism	The religion followed by Jewish people.
Bar Mitzvah	A religious ceremony for a Jewish boy.
Bat Mitzvah	A religious ceremony for a Jewish girl.
synagogue	A place of worship for people of the Jewish faith.
mezuzah	A small box that is placed on the right doorpost of Jewish homes. Inside the box is a parchment scroll with verses from the Torah
Mitzvah Day	A Jewish led day of social action that brings thousands of people together of all faiths and none.
