

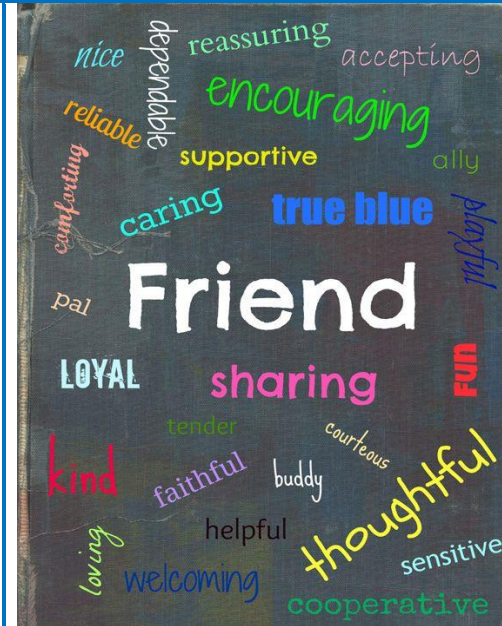

## Important Vocabulary

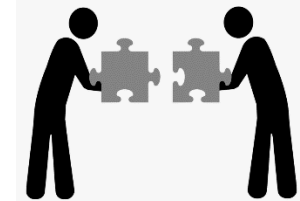
Friendship	People in a friendship have respect and affection for each other.
