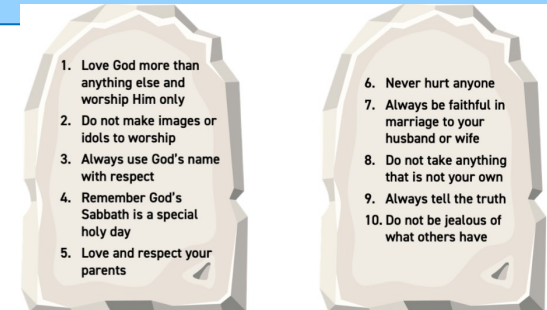


The story of Moses and the ten commandments

Key Knowledge
