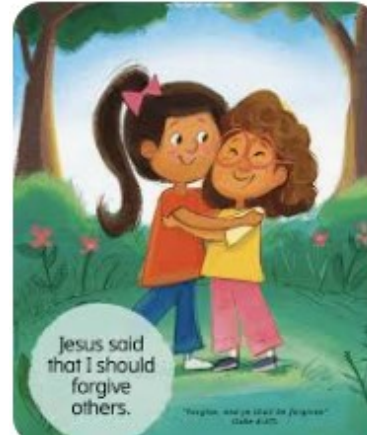


Important Vocabulary

The Lost Son - A Parable is a story that teaches us something.



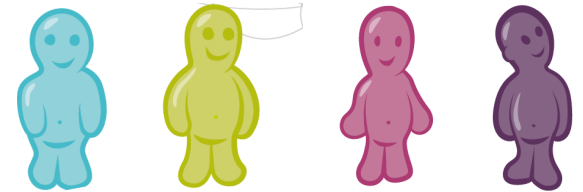
This story teaches us that God is loving and forgiving, just like our parents because the father forgives his son's mistakes.
