

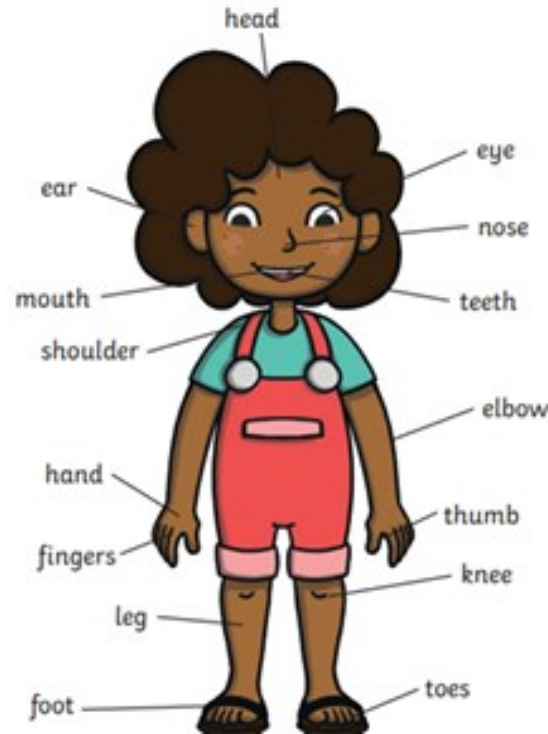

Important Vocabulary

Smell	You smell using your nose. Your nose can tell if things smell nice or not nice.
Body parts	Our body is made up of different parts and they all have different jobs.

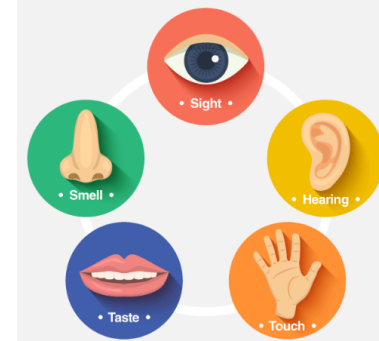

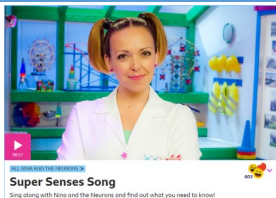
