Dear Parent/Carers,

The learning that has been happening in classes this term so far has been very impressive. At this time of year, the children are really settled and lots of prior learning 'slots into place for them.'



The children in Willow Class have made some huge improvements with their reading in particular recently. Their learning in their phonics sessions is helping them experience success both in reading and their writing.

Thank you for all your reading practice at home - please remember little & often is the best approach for early stages of reading!

In Beech they have been enjoying their science learning; all about life cycles of different animals. Some had been telling me about frogspawn in their ponds at home.

Oak Class too have been focussing well on their learning. Mrs White and Mrs Tedds have noticed what a great attitude they have. 
New Toilets

Author Visits 21st and 23rd May

As part of the Bi-centennial celebrations 2024 and Book week, John Dougherty will be visiting Oak and Beech class on Tuesday 21st May. In 2005 His Zeus on the Loose, was shortlisted for the Branford Boase Award for 'an outstanding first novel for children'. He gave up teaching to concentrate on writing when he moved to Stroud, but he really enjoys visiting schools as an author and poet and his novels and poetry books are a staple in our classrooms.

Eileen Browne will be visiting Willow class on Thursday 23rd May. The children will listen to her talk about her books, the process of writing and illustration as well as sources of inspiration. Handa's Surprise is very familiar to us all and she will explain how a book is made.

The experience of listening to an inspirational author and illustrator is invaluable and can encourage the most reluctant of readers and writers! In addition to this, Eileen is happy to sign copies of her books for your child as a memento of the day. She has also agreed to talk to parents after school about reading picture books aloud and the bias in publishing.

We will be sending out information about how to buy the books via +ParentPay soon but please put the dates in your diary.


Beech Class Swimming

Beech class swimming begins on Friday 7th June. Permission and payment is now available via ParentMail. The children will swim every Friday for 6 weeks.

Chippenham Music Cluster joint Schools Concert, 'Power in Me' Beech class pupils.

The concert will take place on Tuesday 18th June 2024 at the Olympiad Leisure Centre Sports Hall, Monkton Park, Chippenham, Wiltshire, SN15 3PA from 1.00 – 2.30pm. Each school will celebrate music by performing a piece of their own choice relating to a 'Power in Me' theme linking with the 2024 Olympic Games motto 'Faster, Higher, Stronger – Together'. There will also be performances by Wiltshire Music Connect's Associate music tutor DJ Harman and band, with a joint schools song as a finale. Our school is bringing a group of pupils to Beech class at the concert and your child will be taking part in this exciting opportunity. Due to strict hall capacity we have to limit tickets to 2 per family.

Each ticket costs £2 and will be available from school in advance of the concert. Payment will be cash only and tickets will be available for collection week beginning 20th May. The audience entrance to the sport's hall will be at the park / river level of the venue – please don't use main entrance at top of the Olympiad building. Doors will open for the audience at 12.45pm, the concert will start at 1.00pm. Entrance will be by numbered ticket only. The concert is supported and funded by Wiltshire Music Connect, the Music Education Hub for Wiltshire.



The cost of venue, band and sound engineer are paid for from Chippenham music cluster funds. Money raised from ticket sales will go back into the music cluster to support future music education projects for Chippenham schools. Thank you for your support
