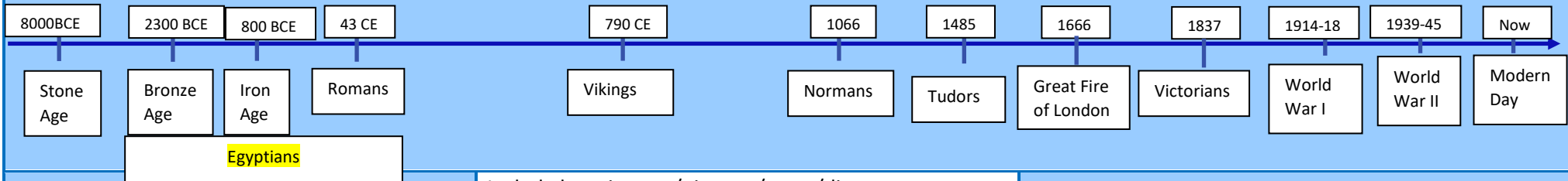

Tutankhamun	A king of Ancient Egypt
Ra	Was the King of creation in Ancient Egypt
Isis	The goddess of fertility in Ancient Egypt.
Osiris	The Ancient Egyptian god of the lower world and judge of the dead.
Horus	The Egyptian god of the sun.
Seth	A trickster. Lord of the desert.
